ACADEMICS

The students of XII and X gave an exemplary performance in their boards. In the Senior Secondary CBSE Board examination we had 297 students who appeared in the session 2023-24. The highest percentage scored was 97% in Medical, 97.6% in Commerce, 95.8% in Non-Medical and 96.8% in Humanities. 57 students scored above 90%. Our 5 Students scored 100 marks in different subjects. 164 students scored above 80%. In the Secondary Board Examination 259 students appeared. Our student Bharti scored 96.8% marks. 11 students scored above 95%, 32 students scored above 90% and 104 above 80%.

The noteworthy achievements of the school towards the end of the eventful year can be summed up in the following manner.

STEPS TAKEN TO IMPROVE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

- Remedial classes are taken about three months before the board exams to improve academic result.

- Regular tests and assessments are taken as a part of curriculum.

- Under the guidance of DAV Centre for Academic Excellence, New Delhi, Content and Need based Seminars and QPI Enhancement Capacity Building Programmes are organized to update the teachers' knowledge and teaching strategies thereby uplifting the academic results.
- Departmental meetings are regularly held by subject teachers to plan and share teaching methods and curriculum.

IN-SERVICE TRAINING AND SEMINARS FOR STAFF MEMBERS AND PARENTS

- A Five days Capacity Building Seminar was organized under the aegis of DAVCAE in which 800 teachers from 14 districts participated. The Seminar taught about improving teaching strategies to improve education.
