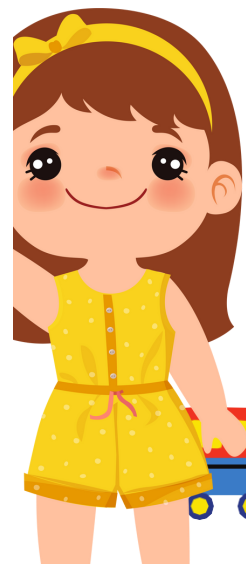
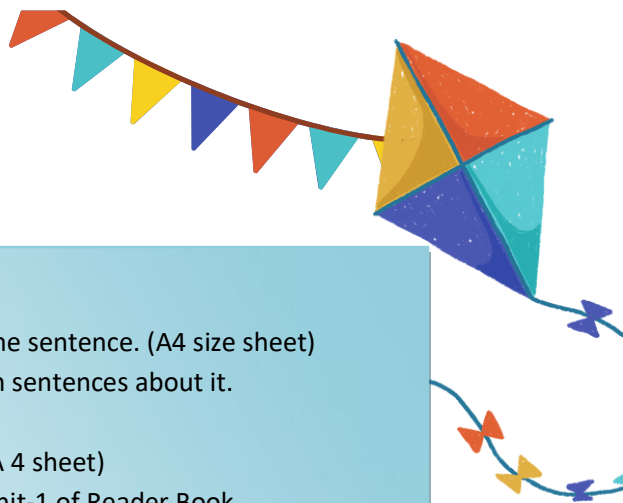

**Example:**  $\frac{2}{3}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$

$\frac{2}{3} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{6}{12}$   
 $\frac{3}{4} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{6}{12}$   
 $6 < 9$   
 So,  $\frac{2}{3} < \frac{3}{4}$
